Planning applications

In April to June 2011, authorities major and minor decisions were undertaking district level planning in England received 120,600 applications for planning permission. In July to September 2011, authorities undertaking district level planning in England received 121,300 applications for planning permission.

This represents a decrease of 4 per cent compared with the corresponding quarter in 2010. In the year ending September 2011, authorities received 471,900 applications, a decrease of 2 per cent on the year ending September 2010 figure.

Planning decisions

District level planning authorities decided 109,200 planning applications in April to June 2011. In July to September 2011 authorities decided 116,100 applications, 3 per cent lower than in the same quarter in the previous year.

Applications granted

In April to June 2011, 89,000 permissions were granted. In July to September 2011, 94,200 permissions were granted, down 3 per cent on the same guarter in 2010, and 87 per cent of all decisions were granted, an increase of 1 percentage point when compared with the September quarter 2010. Overall, 84 per cent of major and minor decisions were granted.

Over the 12 months to tions were processed within 13 September 2011, 350,700 applications were granted, an increase of the year ending September 2010.

In July to September 2011, 58 per cent of major applications were processed within 13 weeks compared with 68 per cent in the September 2010 quarter.
